

The Official Pattern of Dish Rag Tag: the Sequel

Materials: the ball of cotton in the box
US size 6 straight needles (or size needed to obtain gauge)
2 stitch markers

Gauge: roughly 4 stitches to an inch in seed stitch
(finished cloth should be between 8-9" square)

Cast on 35 stitches.

Work in seed stitch for nine rows: *K1, P1 repeat from * to last stitch, K1.

Next Row: (K1, P1) three times, Place Marker, P23, Place Marker, (P1, K1) three times.

Work the following pattern rows between the markers, maintaining the 6 border stitches in established seed stitch pattern.

- 1) K4, *P1, K1, P1, K3 repeat from * to one stitch before marker, K1
- 2) P4, *K3, P3 repeat from * to one stitch before marker, P1
- 3) K4, *P1, K1, P1, K3 repeat from * to one stitch before marker, K1
- 4) Purl
- 5) K1, *P1, K1, P1, K3 repeat from * to four stitches before marker, (P1, K1) twice
- 6) P1, *K3, P3 repeat from * to four stitches before marker, K3, P1
- 7) K1, *P1, K1, P1, K3 repeat from * to four stitches before marker, (P1, K1) twice
- 8) Purl

Repeat these 8 rows three more times.

Work rows 1-4 again removing markers on the last row.

Work eight rows of seed stitch and bind off. Optional: Bind off in pattern for a nice edge.

Weave in ends.
